

10 Advantages of Vertical Grilling Compared to Traditional Grilling!

Traditional Grilling

- On a traditional charcoal grill, the fixed position of the grill does not allow you to control the amount of heat used to cook the food.
- On a traditional grill it is difficult to avoid fumes, flames and charred meat.
- When you grill on a traditional grill, each piece must be turned separately.
- The grill area on a traditional portable grill is often very small.
- Traditional portable grills are often very difficult to clean, and require special cleaning tools.
- When grilling on a traditional grill, you can only cook one kind of food at a time.
- A traditional grill must be placed on a durable surface or in a special stand.
- When using a traditional grill, you can easily damage the food while turning it.
- On a traditional grill it is difficult to prepare steaks, whole chicken, or other large meats.

Vertical Grilling

- Grilling vertically allows you to choose four different heat settings on each side of the grill.
- With the vertical grill you avoid both grill fumes and burning flames from dripping fat, which is much healthier.
- With a grill basket, you can turn all of your food in the same grill basket at once!
- With the vertical BBQ Chef grill, you get double the grilling area.
- With the BBQ Chef grill, you avoid having oil and fat drip into the charcoal, eliminating the need for special and expensive cleaning tools.
- The BBQ Chef grill allows you to mix your food on three separate grilling surfaces!
